If you're 16-18, living in Wales and studying at a school or college, you could get financial help with an Education Maintenance Allowance, known as EMA.

Paid directly to students every two weeks, EMA can help alleviate the stress of costs to stay in education.

What can i use ema for?

That's simple – anything that helps you get through your studies. That could be:



Travel to and from
school or college



Food and
lunches



Study
essentials



Everyday
costs

Essentially, you can spend it on whatever helps you study. It's up to you.

Will it affect family Benefits?

No. We understand this might concern your family, but getting EMA will not affect any benefits paid to your household. This includes Child Benefit, Tax Credits, Universal Credit and Employment and Support Allowance.

EMA is separate from any other benefits, so your family's support stays the same.

Who can get ema?

EMA is designed to help those who need it most, so you're eligible if:

- ✓ You're 16-18 years old
- ✓ You live in Wales
- ✓ You're studying an eligible school or college course
- ✓ You meet attendance requirements
- ✓ Your household income meets the criteria

how much can i get?

Eligible students get £40 per week to help with education costs – this is paid directly to you every two weeks.

When can i apply?

You can apply for EMA at any time. You don't need your GCSE results before applying and you can apply even if you haven't chosen your course yet.

But our tip is to apply online as early as you can, so you get your money as soon as term starts and avoid delays.

how do i apply?

Visit gov.wales/cymru-student-support to check your eligibility and start your application.

You'll get guidance to help you apply and information on what evidence you need for your application.

Mae myfyrwyr cymwys yn cael £40 yr wythnos i helpu gyda chostau addysg - sy'n cael ei dalu'n uniongyrchol i ti bob pythefnos.
