

EMA – School letter / parent email

Dear Headteacher / School Business Manager, We are getting in touch to share information and a digital flyer about the Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA), a Welsh Government scheme that provides £40 per week to help support students in their education. EMA can make a real difference for students who want to continue their education into sixth form or college. It helps with essential costs such as travel, food, study materials, and day-to-day expenses that support their further education. A student may be eligible for EMA if they are aged 16 to 18, living in Wales, studying at school or college, and meet the household income criteria. Why your school's support matters Schools play a crucial role in ensuring that students in Year 10 and 11 and their families are aware of the financial support available to them when exploring their options post-16. This is especially important for young carers, who may face additional pressures at home. Applications for EMA will open on 27th April 2026 so students can apply before they have received their GCSE results or even if they haven't chosen their course yet. By sharing the digital flyer and suggested email attached with parents, you can help ensure that young people who may be eligible for EMA are aware of it and understand how to apply. This includes young carers and those who are eligible for free school meals. Your support will help ensure that young people can access the financial help they may need to support their educational goals. <u>Suggested email copy:</u> Subject: Your child may be eligible for £40 per week to support their future studies Dear Parent/Carer, As your child begins exploring their options for life after Year 11, we want to make you aware of the Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA). This is a Welsh Government payment of £40 per week paid directly to eligible 16-18-year-olds living in Wales and studying at sixth form or college. We are sharing this information now because financial support can play an important role in helping young people decide which post-16 pathway is right for them, including whether to continue into sixth form or college. EMA is designed to help with the everyday costs of staying in education, such as: • Travel to and from school or college • Food and lunches • Study essentials like stationery, equipment or materials • Everyday costs that support learning It's important to note that if your child receives EMA, this will not affect any benefits paid to your household. This includes Child Benefit, Tax Credits, Universal Credit and Employment and Support Allowance.
